These articles will be posted on QLF's website and the GLN Online. GLN Interns will also assist in managing data entry as Alumni sign onto the site; interview Alumni and feature their work and accomplishments each week; assist in directing webinars and online meetings; and assist in facilitating new partnerships and consulting teams among conservation leaders in communities worldwide. QLF is seeking a smart individual who is willing to work hard. Must be an excellent writer and editor; and capable of implementing a program and its evaluation.
