


Adult size: 90 centimetres to 1.5 metres

Habitat: ocean waters from 25 - 1000 metres deep on sand

or mud bottoms


Characteristics: firm flesh and muscles, dark spots



Adult size: 90 centimetres to 1.5 metres

Habitat: ocean waters from 25 - 1500 metres deep

Characteristics: soft, jelly-like muscles



Adult size: 90 centimetres to 1.5 metres

Habitat: ocean waters from 5 - 900 metres deep on rocky

or dark clay bottoms

Characteristics: firm flesh and muscles, vertical stripes
